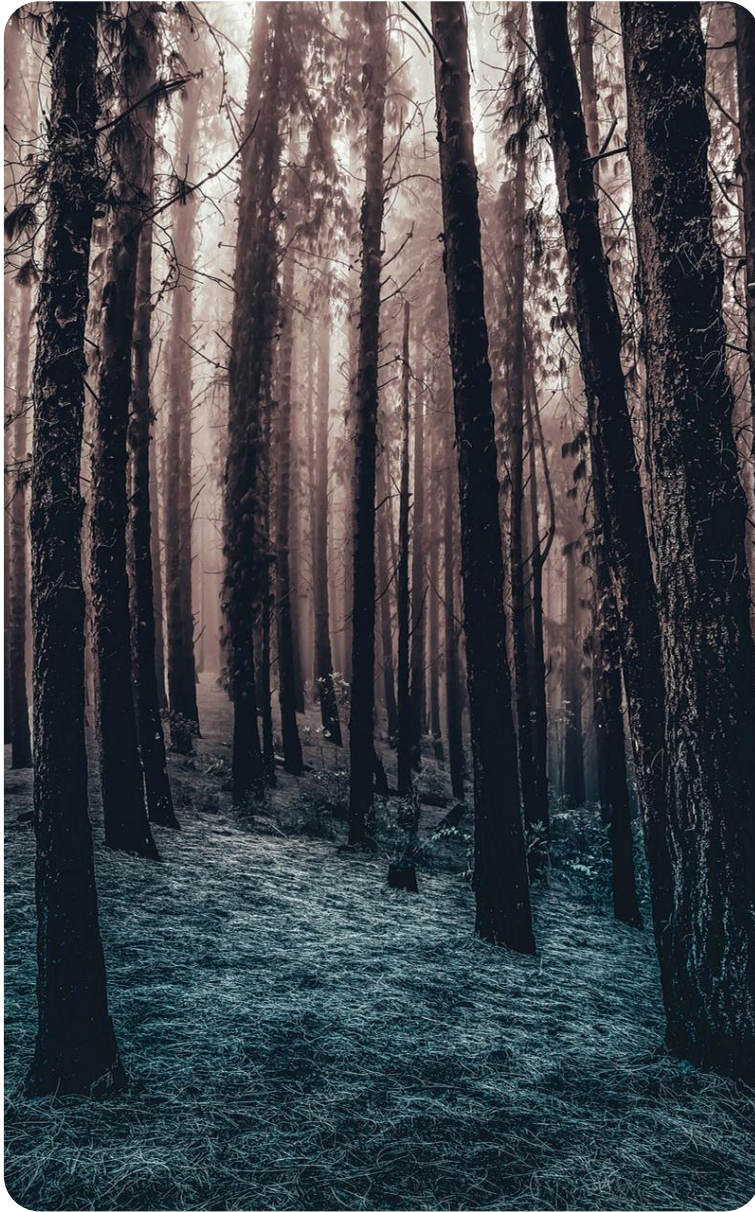
Waste management:

Proper Sorting of Residual Materials

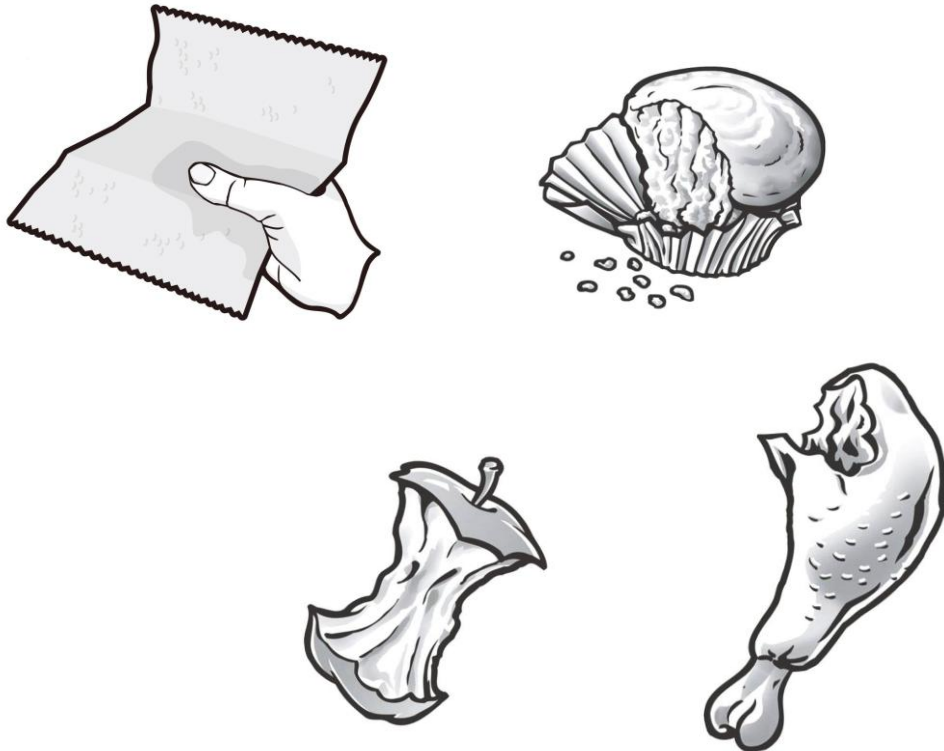
Recyclables



- **Containers, packaging, and printed materials**
- Rinse lightly
- Keep materials separate in the bin

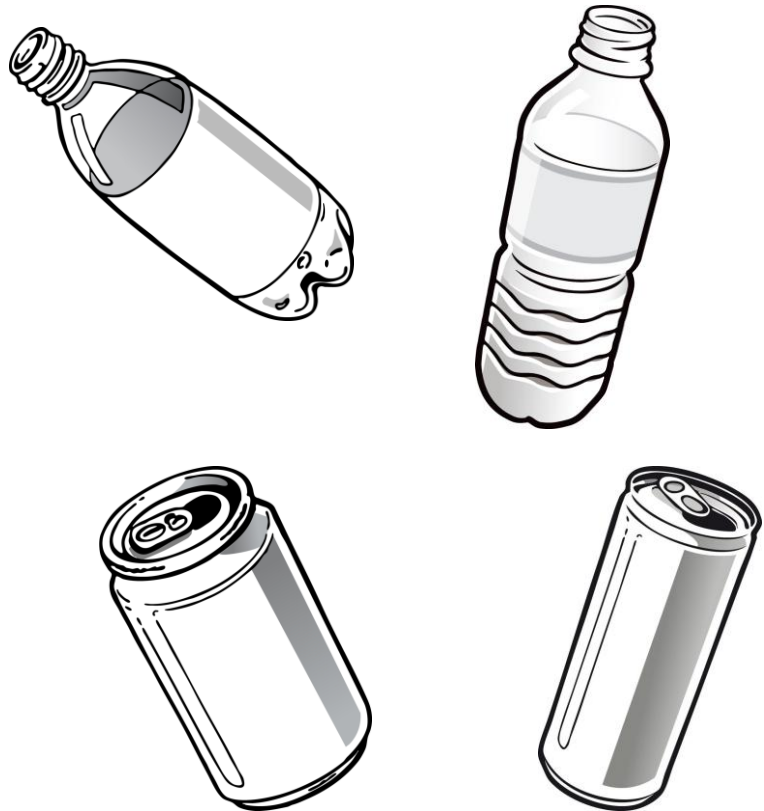

Organics



- Food waste
- Soiled paper and cardboard
- Green waste
- Avoid
“compostable”
plastics

Deposit containers



- Ready-to-drink aluminum and plastic containers (100 ml -2 L)
- Glass containers already covered by deposit (bottled beer and soft drink)
- By 2027: all ready-to-drink containers included
- Collection through Consignation

Practical Tips

- Use the right bin in the right place for each type of material
- Avoid “orphan” trash bins placed without sorting options
- Provide clear signage
- Favour a consistent colour code
- Adapt cleaning procedures and equipment (e.g., carts)
- Recover other materials such as batteries, paint, fluorescent bulbs, and construction residues

The 3Rs + V:

- Not just a question of recycling
- It requires **lasting changes in practice**

Guest Rooms

- Eliminate single-use plastic water bottles
- Install hygiene-product dispensers
- Use dark-coloured towels and sheets (for longer lifespan)
- Switch to rechargeable batteries
- Donate furniture instead of disposing of it

Kitchens

- Measure and track food waste and its causes
- Reduce food waste at the source
- Recover organic materials
- Limit over-packaging
- Maintain and repair equipment to extend its life

Building Maintenance

- Replaceable carpet tiles
- Hand dryers instead of paper towels
- Eco-designed buildings
- Reuse of materials and furniture
